The type of drink says a lot about a person. This particular selection reflects the same kind of ideals as Flohr — down-to-earth, conversational, focused on creating the very best that he can.

Flohr’s lifetime of creating art has taught him how to manipulate oil paint to show everything that he sees and feels. A low light illuminates the bottle and the glass, filtering through the carefully-crafted liquor. Rich amber tones cut through soft blue shadows. This is a drink for sipping slowly, savoring over a long and well-deserved respite.

Gentleman Jack references some of Michael Flohr’s earliest work, when the young artist painted the bar scene in San Francisco. As a student at the Academy of Art University, Flohr earned recognition from the De Young Museum for his painting of Irish Coffee, a drink made famous by San Francisco’s Buena Vista Café. Flohr applies his talent to the places, the people, and the iconic labels that he observes. Today, his style continues to mature like a fine bottle of whiskey.
